Project Update - September 2025

EPBC PER Public Comment Period Open

The Project has received a Direction to Publish for the Public Environment Report (PER) from a delegate of the Federal Minister for the Environment and Water. The public comment period will run for 20 business days from Wednesday 10 September at 8am to Wednesday 8 October at 5pm AEST. Following the 20 day comment period, RES will draft a Final Public Environment Report, updated taking into account any relevant comments received.



Minor Change Approval

On 3 September 2025, SARA provided an updated decision notice approving minor changes to the project layout. Minor changes to existing Development Approvals are a normal part of the development process and in this case was submitted to ensure that the project layout contemplated under the Project's Development Approval aligns with the layout used for the EPBC Public Environment Report (PER) process.

Community Consultative Committee (CCC)

The CCC meetings have commenced with the first 3 meetings held in March, June and September. Meeting minutes will continue to be made available on the Tarong West Project website.

Baseline Dust Monitoring

The baseline dust monitoring is continuing around the Project area. The gauges will continue to be monitored and maintained over the coming months and is expected to conclude in December 2025.
